



As mentioned in a recent update, part of our focus is reaching the unreached. Denise and I have just returned from 14 days in West Africa. The second half of the trip was heading up country with the Chinns, WorldVenture's Africa Directors and seeing first hand one of the unreached people groups we are strategizing to reach.

The trip north was a 7 hour, bouncing ride to where the Chinns had lived. The next day, we drove up into the mountains for about an hour over a very rough dirt road, breaking the rear bumper in the process. When we got to the end of the road, it was a 45 minute hike up a trail to a remote village where we met with the village elders and saw the situation. This group has their own secret religious practices. The picture below is us at a stopping point about half way to the village.



This particular people group numbered about 15,000 people in over 9+ villages. There is one small church among all of them. After returning from the mountain, the pastor of that church asked if I would preach the next day, Sunday, at

the church. So on Sunday, after another hour long bumping ride on a dirt road, we arrived at the church. After I preached (the pastor translated), there came a time for the offering, announcements, and recognizing visitors. This is where it became interesting.

There were two visitors, one of whom wanted to accept Christ. So, in front of the congregation, the pastor talked to her, prayed for her, and then she prayed to accept Christ. As soon as the "Amen" was said, we opened our eyes, and the congregation started to point to where we were all sitting on the platform at the front and they started to clear out. Just above us, coming out of the rafters, was a large white snake. We immediately left the platform and watched as the men of the church started throwing sticks and rocks at what (we learned later) was a very dangerous snake. Eventually the snake was hit, fell to the floor, and was killed. Was the timing coincidence? Maybe, but more likely, given the spiritual nature of that area, I would say not.

Such is the nature of the work to reach the unreached. We continue to travel and so appreciate your support and prayers for us. Denise and I will be traveling again this month. Keep praying!
