Opening the gate, we listened as the 10 year old boy standing there told us that he had been waiting at our gate since 4:00 am. His mother had gotten really sick during the night and sent him to ask for money so she could go to the doctor. In a world of such despair, we are blessed to be your hands and feet to Rwanda. It is amazing what a difference just a few dollars can make...."
