6) The mark of a person who is making a difference is someone who has great enthusiasm for what God is doing in others -
7) The mark of a person who has made a difference lives with the confidence that there is nothing to fear and nothing to regret in serving the gospel of Christ – Phil. 2:17-18

Intro: Paul anticipates that his life may be poured out like a drink offering on the sacrifice and service of the faith of the Philippian believers and in the face of possible death he rejoices – that tells us something about how he sees his life and the lives that he has touched by the power of Christ.
1) The Mark of a person who is making a difference lives with a conviction that God is actively working in his own life – Phil. 1:6
2) The Mark of a person who is making a difference is someone who shares the gospel because it alone can chang our eternal destiny – Phil. 1:21
3) The mark of a person who is making a difference willingly pours out her life for others because she is convinced that God is using her – Phil. 1:24-25
