# Open Communion Sunday: Instructions for Sharing 2/14/2016

#### Theme: "Working out our salvation with fear and trembling"

"Open Communion" is where we give opportunity for each person to come forward and share a few thoughts about the theme we are focusing on this morning: Working out our salvation. In sharing, you can focus on the theme as you have learned about it from our series, share how Christ's story is our salvation, or share your own story about how God is challenging and changing you as you work out your salvation (recognizing that God Himself is at work in your life).

Christ's story: Christ is our salvation - share with us how the Bible teaches us that salvation is in Christ.

Your story: How are you working out your salvation? How is the Spirit bearing fruit in your life as you are seriously thinking through the fact that God is personally at work to fulfill His will and good pleasure in and through your life. If you need help thinking about how to share your story, anything that has challenged you from the book of Philippians is pretty safe as to how you are working out your salvation.

#### Consider these prompts in thinking about how to share your story:

- How has God challenged your beliefs, values, priorities, behaviors, habits or character related to the reality that He is at work in you?
- How do you see His work in you? (Phil. 1:6)
- How are you walking worthy of the gospel? (1:27)
- What has it meant to do nothing from selfishness or empty conceit? (2:3-4)
- What are you learning about being a light in the world?
- How are you learning about being a genuine servant?
- Would others say you have proven character?
- Are you learning to be a risk-taker?

#### How to participate:

- 1. **Go to the microphone.** If someone is already there (or at the other mic), wait patiently behind that person until they are done.
- 2. Be Concise. Keep comments short. You should not be up there for more than 2 minutes.
- 3. Stay on topic. Focus, focus, focus. Stay on the theme and don't wander.
- 4. **Don't preach.** Share what impacts you from God's Word and what you are learning; people will make the connection.
